A limited number of scholarships are also available.

Parents/Guardians will be invited to a special **PARENTS' PROGRAM, RECEPTION, COLLEGE FAIR & EXHIBITION** of work by their children on Saturday, June 2, 2012, at the Worcester Art Museum.
