ACCESSIBILITY

- All Museum galleries are wheelchair and stroller accessible—a few wheelchairs are available for loan at the Lancaster and Salisbury Welcome Centers.
- Elevators are located on all four floors of the Museum— for assistance using WAM's elevators, ask one of our GSRs.
- Service and emotional support animals are always welcome.
- Personal care attendants are admitted free of charge.

LIGHTEN YOUR LOAD

- To ensure the safety of the collection, the Museum does not permit visitors to carry bags on their backs in the galleries.
- Extra-large backpacks, beverages, and food must be left behind before entering the Museum. Ask our GSRs about storage options, including private lockers.
- Smaller backpacks, pocketbooks, and satchels are allowed as long as you carry them by your side.



TAKE A BREAK

- Seating is available in multiple locations throughout the Museum — if you need a seat, ask a gallery attendant for assistance.



RESTROOMS

- Restrooms are located on the 1st, 2nd and 4th floors of the Museum and the 1st and 2nd floors of the Higgins Education Wing.
- Breastfeeding and bottle feeding are permitted throughout the Museum.
- Baby-changing stations are available in the 1st floor and 2nd-floor restrooms.

- The Museum Café is open Wednesday-Saturday 11:30am-2pm.
- Sip snack cart in the Lancaster Welcome Center is open Wednesday-Saturday 10am-3pm, Sunday 11am-3pm.
